- Our masking tapes and backing papers are with a percentage of 0,5 – 12% depending the weight of unit area with silicon coated, this is no hazardous substance pursuant to the hazardous substance regulation and according the EG-Guidelines.
 - Since halogen atoms are part of many officially registered chemical substances for use in release papers, the absence of these atoms cannot be guaranteed in principle.
- Drying Bags are not used in our packaging!
