

Confirmation of Material Compliance

Scope regarding product groups and their packaging:

- **Adhesive tapes**
- **Stretch films, shrink films and top sheets**
- **Rubber bands**
- **Strapping bands**
- **Cardboard packaging, Cardboard edge protectors, anti slip paper**

Based on the declarations and evidence provided by our upstream suppliers, we hereby confirm compliance with the material and regulatory limits listed below for the product range mentioned above:

1. Heavy metal limits (Art. 5 Para. 4 PPWR / Directive 94/62/EC)

The sum of the concentration levels of lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium in the supplied items and their components does not exceed the legally established limit.

2. REACH compliance (Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006)

The supplied items meet the requirements of the REACH Regulation. To the best of our current knowledge, they do not contain any substances from the current REACH Candidate List (SVHC – Substances of Very High Concern) in a concentration exceeding 0.1% **by weight (w/w)**. Information obligations pursuant to **Art. 33 of the REACH Regulation** are strictly monitored.

3. POP compliance (Regulation (EU) 2019/1021)

The items comply with the requirements of the Regulation on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POP). The substances listed in Annexes I and II of this Regulation are not contained in the products or fall under Art. 4, 1 b).

4. PFAS restrictions (Art. 5 Para. 5 PPWR)

Pursuant to **Art. 5 Para. 5 PPWR**, specific PFAS concentration limits (25 ppb / 250 ppb / 50 ppm) apply to **"food contact packaging"** (food contact materials).

Consequently, there is no legal requirement regarding PFAS for these items.

5. Bisphenol restrictions (Regulation (EU) 2024/3190)

The restrictions concerning bisphenols likewise apply exclusively to materials in direct contact with food.
